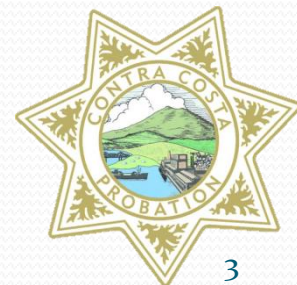

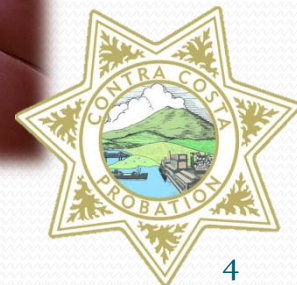

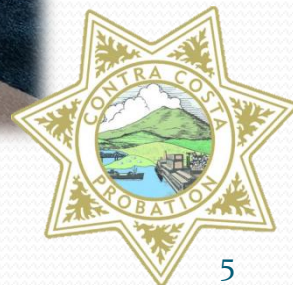
Briones Youth Academy Program Framework



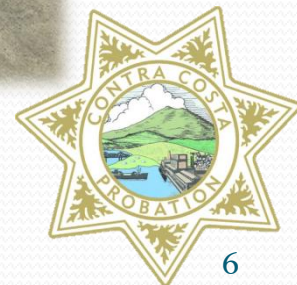

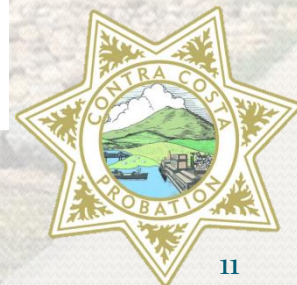
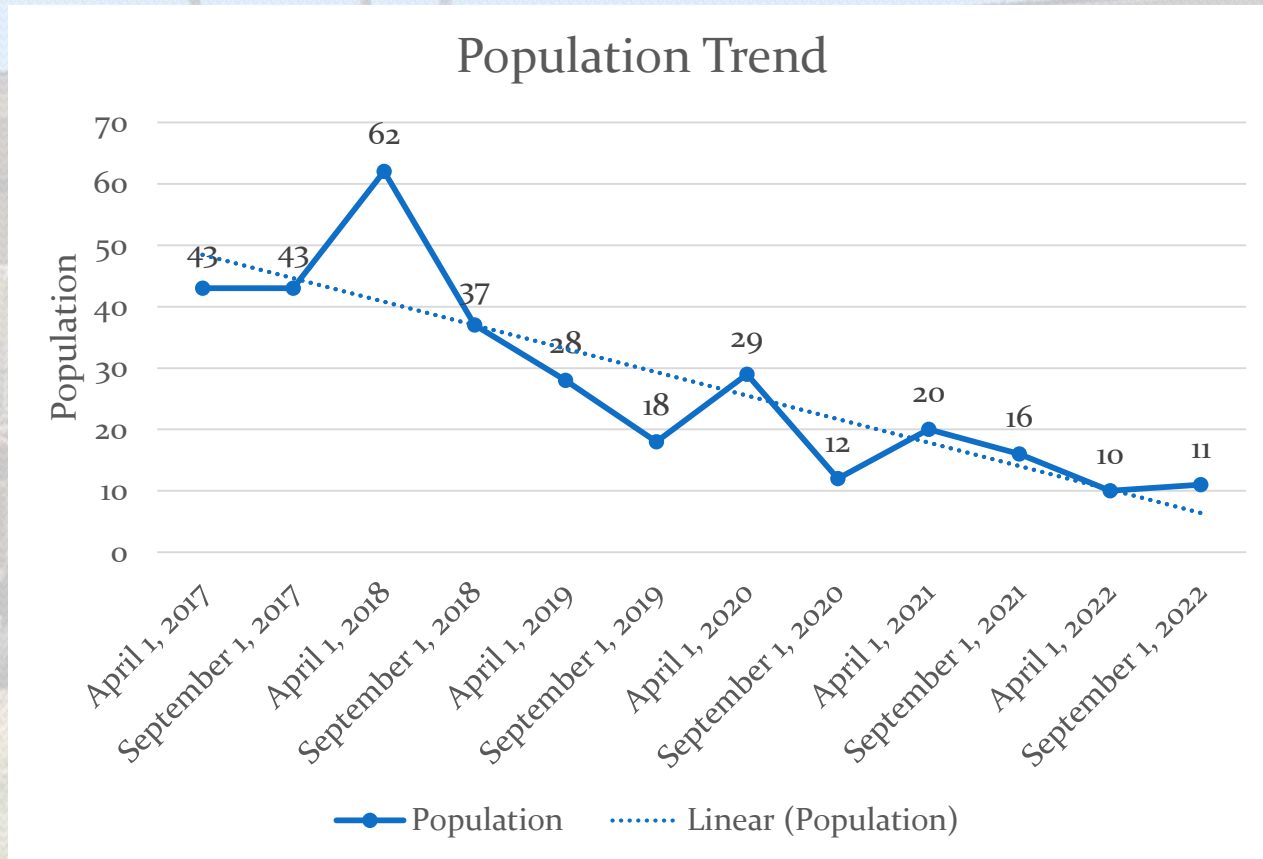


Briones Youth Academy: Community Path

- Intensive home-based program
 - Community-based alternative to OAYRF commitment
 - Less-secure “step-down” option, per SB 823
- Increase capacity and expand partnership opportunities with non-governmental organizations
- Expose youth to greater academic and career technical educational opportunities
- Family stabilization and reunification services
- Continued use of Evidence-Based Practices
