Yvonne Wadleigh is a registered nurse who was most recently the Director of Emergency and Trauma Services at Eden Medical Center in Castro Valley, CA. In this position she was responsible for the strategic workforce planning, day-to-day operations, disaster response and the implementation of the department's response to COVID-19 to maintain safety for 120 employees and average 150 patients seen daily. Additionally, she led efforts in certification and establishment of hospital emergency and trauma services for White House contingencies in the Bay Area. She led budget development and resourcing for her departments, managed extensive human resource and labor/union issues, developed and managed training and responsible for adherence to regulatory standards. Her nursing career includes nursing positions with direct patient care in medical/surgical and intensive care units and leadership positions in emergency/trauma, step down and universal care, as well as various process improvement committees such as patient safety.

Her community involvement spans decades and includes leadership roles in many parent organizations and sports leagues as well as extensive volunteerism in public school classrooms supporting academics and church programs.
