

In the matter of: Resolution No. 2022/8

Recognizing the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District for 25 years of service to the residents of Contra Costa County.

WHEREAS, the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District was formed on July 1, 1997, as an independent special district, through the consolidation of the Moraga Fire Protection District and the Orinda Fire Protection District, to provide more efficient fire protection, rescue, emergency medical, hazardous material response, ambulance, and any other services relating to the protection of lives and property; and

WHEREAS, over the past 25 years, the staff of the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District has grown to 65 full-time public safety professionals who responded to more than 3,253 emergency assistance calls last year; and

WHEREAS, the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District continues to provide fire protection, rescue, and emergency medical services in the City of Orinda, the Town of Moraga, some adjacent unincorporated county areas, the community of Canyon, and automatic aid into Lafayette and State Responsibility Areas that lie within their District's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District provide mutual aid to lend assistance across jurisdictional boundaries to assist with major disasters, fires, and other emergency responses, including the recent Caldor, Dixie, River Complex, SCU Lightning Complex, and Lava Fires; and

WHEREAS, the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District celebrates its 25 years of service in July 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District Board of Directors does hereby acknowledge and thank the Moraga-Orinda Fire Protection District for 25 years of preserving life and property in service to the residents of Contra Costa County.
