I help clients address these barriers.

	I work with a very diverse client population, and strive to listen to the goals of each client and then let them know the best legal strategy to achieve that goal. I understand that there are many factors that will influence each client's goals. I also use different tools to connect with clients, such as varied methods of communication, translation services, meeting clients at my office or out in the community, etc. I also work closely with trusted medical care providers or case managers to connect with my clients.

I also provide trainings to Community Connect case managers within CCHS, who assist unhoused individual or individuals at risk of losing their housing, on how to spot legal issues upstream and assist low-income tenants before they become homeless.
