My approach to those that are currently homeless is to find what resources they need the most. For some, it is health care, housing, food, or work. We serve anyone, no matter what their background is. We have found over the years that the best way to approach each person through harm-reductive, client-centered care.

I believe there is a huge problem with communication and referrals to supportive housing. One of the properties I have staff working at is called the Idaho Property in El Cerrito. We have struggled to fill these HOPWA beds for the payear, and there were rooms that say empty due to the grant being written incorrectly. There needs to be more support staff like the Housing Navigators I supervise in Alameda County. These HN help the homeless clients become document ready and continue to support the client after they are housed.
