NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 4, 2023, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 will be held with respect to a proposed plan of finance for the issuance by the California Municipal Finance Authority (the "Authority") of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 (together with a like amount of refunding obligations) (the "Bonds") to: (1) finance or refinance the acquisition and rehabilitation of a 50-unit qualified residential rental project for low-income seniors to be located at 710 Willow Avenue, in the unincorporated community of Rodeo in the County of Contra Costa, California (the "County"); and (2) pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The facilities are to be owned and operated by Rodeo Gateway II, L.P., a California limited partnership, or another ownership entity to be created by EAH Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, or an affiliate thereof (such limited partnership or other ownership entity, the "Borrower").

The Bonds and the obligation to pay principal thereof and interest thereon and any redemption premium with respect thereto do not constitute indebtedness or an obligation of the County, the Authority, the State of California or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation, or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of any of them. The Bonds shall be a limited obligation of the Authority, payable solely from certain revenues duly pledged therefor and generally representing amounts paid by the Borrower.
