IN THE MATTER OF: 2022-2023 State of California Department of Community Services and Development, Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) Amendment 1.

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2022, the County received notification of amendment from the California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) for the 2022 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) agreement, and **WHEREAS**, the amendment is the remaining allocation of 2022 LIHEAP Agreement that CSD is releasing for the grant, and **WHEREAS**, the County routinely receives funding from CSD wherein Contra Costa County provides energy bill assistance payments and/or Weatherization services to residents who are income eligible through LIHEAP and the Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP), and **WHEREAS**, first priority for services are to those households with the lowest income and highest energy burden, and **WHEREAS**, LIHEAP priority is to service those households with the following vulnerable populations: young children (ages five years or under), disabled, and elderly persons (ages 60 years or older), and **WHEREAS**, this Board is to accept additional funds for the Program year 2022-2023 in the amount of \$1,057,688.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ADOPT Resolution No. 2022/XXX to approve and authorize the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute an amendment to the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) revenue agreement to accept additional funds in the amount of \$1,057,688 and increase the total funding limit in an amount not to exceed \$4,446,906 with the State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) with no changes to term period of November 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023.
