# **Supervisor Burgis Comments:**

- a. Suggested staff research if it is possible to gather data from Mobile Citizen App reports to identify if multiple reports were submitted for the same dump/incident and identify if the same location keeps experiencing dumping.
- b. Reminded public listening that these efforts are for unincorporated Contra Costa and the other 19 incorporated cities have their own programs of dealing with illegal dumping separate from county efforts.
- c. Suggested staff create a presentation to reflect opportunities for cities to activate for Mayor's Conference. To give other cities the idea to be more assertive and active in addressing illegal dumping. A more united front with policies and approaches may help prevent dumping from being pushed one place to another.
- d. Suggested staff contact PG&E to discuss attaching surveillance cameras to PG&E polls monitor illegal dumping as well as wildfires and arson.

## **Supervisor Glover Comments:**

- a. Requested staff report out on Mobile Citizen App case open, and cases closed to identify successes and how fast staff is responding to reports.
- b. Encouraged program efforts to be flexible as community needs may change and particular efforts may no longer be needed and encouraged staff and committee members to discuss and make determinations as needed.
