



Illegal Dumping Incidents Reported in 2022

Strategy #45: Illegal Dumping Deputies

August 2022 - January 2023 Highlights:

- 63 submissions thru Mobile Citizen App. for clean-up.
- 8 Deputy Investigation Reports and 1 citation issued and submitted to DA for filing.
- 4 Incidents of illegal dumping cleaned-up by suspect prior to enforcement action.
- 4 Incidents reported from surveillance cameras monitoring service, no leads or suspect information obtained.



Report Illegal Dumping Signs
