
WHEREAS, Sheriff Rupf served in the United States Marine Corps; and

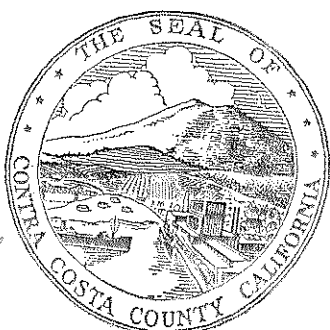
