**IN THE MATTER OF HONORING
BOBBI NUGENT
FOR HER ADMIRABLE EFFORTS TO ENSURE
ALL CHILDREN ARE PROTECTED
UNDER MEGAN'S LAW**

RESOLUTION NO. 2009/153

WHEREAS, Bobbi Nugent has a special-needs child who, three years ago, was scheduled to attend Spectrum Center School in Pittsburg. While Bobbi investigated the school and neighborhood, she was disturbed to find the school was not listed on the Megan's Law website as it did not fall under the classification as a public school. This means registered sex offenders could and did live nearby the school – 134 in total within 2000 feet of the school; and

WHEREAS, Bobbi Nugent became the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) President for Discovery Bay Elementary School for the school year 2006-2007 and used this opportunity to express her concern for the Megan's Law oversight. During Bobbi's tenure as President, she drafted a resolution to go to the California PTA titled "Promoting the Inclusion of Non-Public Schools on the Attorney Generals Internet Web Site;" and


WHEREAS, Bobbi Nugent's advocacy led to the resolution's approval locally and by the Delta Council PTA and is now being forwarded to the State Board of Managers. If approved, this resolution will be presented to the convention delegates this spring. If approved, the resolution will be communicated to all the local chapters to encourage them to contact their legislature; and

WHEREAS, Bobbi Nugent's service and dedication to the safety of children has aided the expansion of the Megan's Law website and the service to all families with children, including those with preschoolers and special needs; and





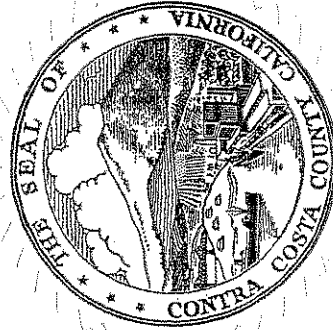
