WHEREAS, Nick Pica took first place at the North Coast Section Wrestling Championships at 189 pounds as a freshman and sophomore at De La Salle High School in Concord; and

WHEREAS, after being forced to sit out his junior year at Concord High School due to an injury, Nick started his senior year playing football and winning all-league honors on both offense and defense; and


WHEREAS, after defeating the state's number one ranked wrestler in the 215-pound weight class, Drew Meulman of St. Francis, Nick moved into the No. 1 spot in the state and won his third NCS title in as many tries and was top seed going into the state finals; and


WHEREAS, Nick Pica made history when he became the first wrestler from Concord High School to win a State Championship by defeating Meulman 10-4 at the state finals in Bakersfield completing the season with a 39-0 record; and

WHEREAS, Nick made his fellow Minutemen, family, and friends proud as he went on to take third place at the National Championships;

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors honors Nick Pica for his dedication and hard work as he became the first wrestler in the history of Concord High School to win a State Championship.

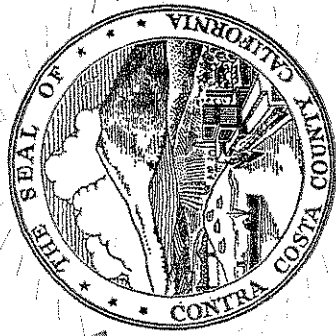
