

WHEREAS, the Festival acknowledges and encourages nurturing, caring, and loving values inherent within all of us; and


WHEREAS, by protecting and preserving the integrity and mutual respect of all individuals and organizations, diversity is achieved; and

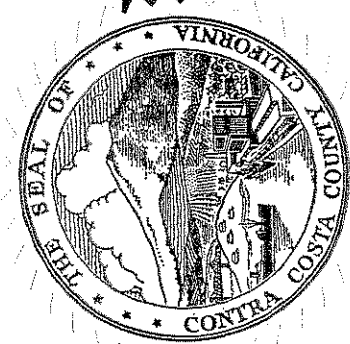
