RESOLUTION NO. 2009/168

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2009 the American Brotherhood Aimed Towards Education of California (ABATE) Local #15 is sponsoring a motorcycle event in Contra Costa County to promote Motorcycle Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, ABATE is an organization that is actively promoting safe operation, increased rider training, and increased motorist awareness of motorcycles; and
