

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-10
(uncodified)

(Fee for Coroner's Removal and Keeping of Dead Body)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Authority.

This ordinance is enacted pursuant to Government Code sections 27472 and 54985(a).

SECTION II. Body Removal and Keeping Fee – Amount.

The fee for the coroner's removal of a body from the place of death and keeping the body is two hundred sixty-seven (\$267) dollars. This fee may be charged and collected by the coroner as permitted in Government Code section 27472.

SECTION III. Fee Schedule.

The Office of the Sheriff-Coroner fee schedule shall be revised to be consistent with this ordinance.

SECTION IV. Prior Fee Repealed.

Section III of Ordinance No. 92-78 is repealed.
