Pursuant to Section 22358 of the California Vehicle Code, the following speed limits are established for the unincorporated portions of Camino Diablo (Road No. 7941), Brentwood/Byron area.

50 miles per hour, beginning at the intersection of Marsh Creek Road and extending easterly to a point 0.25 miles west of Holway Drive, and

35 miles per hour, from a point 0.25 miles west of Holway Drive and extending easterly to the intersection of Byron Highway.

Traffic Resolution No. 2004/4066 pertaining to the existing speed limits is hereby rescinded.
