ORDINANCE NO. 2009-34 (uncodified)

(Clerk-Recorder Electronic Recording Delivery System Fee)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Authority. This ordinance is authorized by Government Code section 27397(c)(1).

SECTION II. Fee Adoption. On and after January 1, 2010, the one dollar (\$1) fee authorized by Government Code section 27397(c)(1) shall be charged and collected for each instrument that is recorded in the Office of the Clerk-Recorder.

SECTION III. Restrictions. The funds generated by the fee authorized by this ordinance shall be used by the Clerk-Recorder only for recovering the reasonable total costs of an electronic recording system, the review and approval of vendors and potential authorized submitters, security testing as required by Government Code sections 27390 through 27399 and the regulations of the California Attorney General, and reimbursement to the California Attorney General for regulation and oversight of the electronic recording delivery system.

SECTION IV. Fee Schedule. The Clerk-Recorder fee schedule shall be revised to be consistent with this ordinance.

SECTION V. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage. Within 15 days of passage, this ordinance shall be published once with the names of the supervisors voting for and against it in the Contra Costa Times, a newspaper published in this County.
