Resolution No. 2010/45

In the Matter of Approving the Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding between Contra Costa County and SEIU Local 1021 Rank & File Unit to include the corrected language in Section 12.4.A.

Whereas, The Board of Supervisors adopted the Memorandum of Understanding between Contra Costa County and SEIU Local 1021 Rank & File Unit on July 21, 2009. Whereas since that adoption, it was noted the language should have included additional language in Section 12.4.A – Holiday is Worked and Holiday Falls on Regularly Scheduled Day Off of Full-Time Employees on 4/10, 9/80, Flexible, and Alternate Work Schedules. Add the following sentence after the second sentence in Section 12.4.A: "The employee is also entitled to receive eight (8) hours of flexible pay, at the rate of 1.0 times his/her base rate of pay, in recognition of his/her scheduled day off." The tentative agreements showing these changes are attached.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County AMENDS Section 12.4.A of the Memorandum of Understanding between Contra Costa County and SEIU Local 1021 Rank & File Unit to add the following sentence after the second sentence in Section 12.4.A: "The employee is also entitled to receive eight (8) hours of flexible pay, at the rate of 1.0 times his/her base rate of pay, in recognition of his/her scheduled day off."
