WHEREAS, the County employees encourage the public to participate by donating funds, food and volunteer energy to the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano online in a corresponding "people-to-people" challenge between the counties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County hereby commends, encourages, and challenges employees and residents of Contra Costa and Solario counties to open their hearts and wallets to assist the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano, and its client organizations during the coming holiday season; and
