WHEREAS, Pleasant Hill was incorporated on November 7, 1961; and

WHEREAS, Pleasant Hill has maintained a community-based atmosphere filled with unique people passionate about sustaining its naturally beautiful landscapes since its incorporation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasant Hill boasts an award winning city hall, built in 1991, which embodies its rural heritage and incorporates the city's dedication to nature by including a peaceful park, pond and

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasant Hill has fifteen parks and other open-space areas; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Pleasant Hill have hosted a weekly Farmers Market annually since 1982 during the warm season, which allows people to buy and sell succulent fruits and locally grown vegetables, while enjoying the merriments of live music and entertainment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasant Hill has held an annual Community Service Day for the past seven years in which citizens team up for the city's greater good; a day reminiscent of the early Pleasant Hill area when farmers would band together to assist in their fellowman's harvest; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasant Hill has been committed to teaching its history, as it hosted a monthly program in 2011 at Rodgers Ranch which chronologically covered the city's saga, decade by decade; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasant Hill has furthered its efforts to inform citizens of the lesser-known attributes of the city by scheduling open houses during which historical art and photographs have been on display alongside the works of modern local artists and photographers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors hereby honors the City of Pleasant Hill for 50 years of excellence to its citizens and for its orgoing contributions of beauty and individuality to Contra Costa County.
