WHEREAS, Councilmember Mendonca was elected to the Moraga Town Council November 2008 and served as the Vice Mayor in 2010 and Mayor in 2011, and also served on the Parks and Recreation Commission from 2007-2008; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Mendonca represented the Town of Moraga on the Central Contra Costa Solid Waste Authority, serving as chair from March 2011-2012, was Moraga's delegate to the League of California Cities and to the Contra Costa County Mayors' Conference, and also served as the liaison to the Association of Bay Area Governments; and


WHEREAS, Councilmember Mendonca served as a member of the Moraga's Audit and Finance Committee, the Open Space Committee, the St. Mary's College Subcommittee, and was the liaison to the Moraga Youth Involvement Committee and School District.






