## Resolution No. 2012/514

Grant Award Agreement for Funding of Regional Anti-Drug Abuse Program Grant Funding.

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors, Contra Costa County, desires to undertake a certain project designated as the Regional Anti-Drug Abuse Team Grant Program supported by the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney, or designee, of the County of Contra Costa is authorized on its behalf to execute, on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, a grant award agreement and any extensions or amendments thereof, pursuant to State guidelines, with the Board of State and Community Corrections for funding for the Regional Anti-Drug Abuse Program in the amount of \$354,515 for the period October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that federal grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures previously authorized or controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney's office and partnering entities agree to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the federal Justice Assistance Grant Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the Board of State and Community Corrections.
