CREATING ZONE 1202 OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA P-6 IN THE CONCORD AREA

This Board recognizes the need for increased police protection services in the above subject zone and the difficulty of funding the current or an increased level of services. Establishing the subject zone is a necessary step for the Board of Supervisors to seek voter approval of a special tax for increased police protection services in the zone area. Government Code sections 25217 and 25217.1 establish procedures for the formation of a zone within a county service area.

- 1. It is in the public interest to provide an increased level of police protection services in the area of proposed Zone 1202 of County Service Area P-6. 2. A majority protest against the proposed formation of Zone 1202 does not exist, pursuant to Government Code section 25217.1, subdivision (b).
- 3. Subject to voter approval of Ordinance No. 2012-14 on February 12, 2013, authorizing the levy of a special tax within proposed Zone 1202, that portion of Contra Costa County Service Area P-6 described in Exhibit A attached hereto and shown in Exhibit B attached hereto is established as Zone 1202 of County Service Area P-6, effective upon this Board's adoption of a resolution declaring the results of the February 12. 2013, election ("Effective Date").
- 4. No affected properties located in Zone 1202 will be taxed for any existing bonded indebtedness or contractual obligations as a result of the formation of said zone.
- 5. On or after the Effective Date, the Clerk of this Board shall cause the filing of a statement of the creation of said zone to be made with the County Assessor and the State Board of Equalization (in Sacramento) pursuant to Government Code sections 54900-54902. The filing shall include a map or plat indicating the boundaries of said zone.
