WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Employment and Human Services Department contracts with and receives funding from the California Department of Aging to provide Title III and Title VII services, and

WHEREAS, the contract amendment (AP-1213-07, Amendment 1) reallocates unspent federal funds from Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12 to FY 2012-13 and adjusts initial Area Plan allocations for Title III and Titel VII programs, One-Time-Only funding for FY 2012-13, and,

WHEREAS the contract amendment increases funds to the County, and,

WHEREAS the funds will be used to enhance Title IIII and Title VII program service levels.
