ORDINANCE NO. 2013-09

(Change Appointing Authority for County Probation Officer-Exempt; Move Assistant County Probation Officer-exempt from Section 33-5.391 to new subsection (b) of Section 33-5.345; Retitle; and Repeal Section 33-5.391)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows (omitting the parenthetical footnotes from the official text of the enacted or amended provisions of the County Ordinance Code):

SECTION I: Section 33-5.345 of the County Ordinance Code is retitled, and is amended to change the appointing authority of the county probation officer-exempt from the judge of the juvenile court to the board of supervisors, in new subsection (a) of Section 33-5.345, and to move the classification of assistant county probation officer-exempt from Section 33-5.391 to new subsection (b) of Section 33-5.345, to read:

Section 33-5.345- County Probation

- (a) The county probation officer-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the board of supervisors.
- (b) The assistant county probation officer-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the county probation officer.

SECTION II: Section 33-5.391 of the County Ordinance Code is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION III: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days of passage shall be published once with the names of the supervisors voting for and against it in the Contra Cools Times, a newspaper published in this County.
