IN THE MATTER OF:

Approval of the Settlement Agreement between Contra Costa County and Professional and Technical Engineers IFPTE, Local 21 regarding representation of temporary employees employed in classifications represented by Local 21.

WHEREAS Local 21 brought a grievance against Contra Costa County regarding certain employees in the classifications Local 21 represents; and

WHEREAS the Director of Human Resources entered into a Settlement Agreement with Local 21 in or about July 2013, providing that Local 21 will be the formally recognized employee organization for temporary employees who are employed by Contra Costa County to perform temporary services in those classifications that are represented by Local 21; and

WHEREAS the Settlement Agreement also provides that for those temporary employees who are retired from Contra Costa County service, the subjects of health benefits, dental benefits, and retirement benefits are excluded from the scope of representation, notwithstanding Government Code section 3504; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors, in its capacity as governing Board of the County of Contra Costa and all districts of which it is ex-officio governing Board, hereby approves the Settlement Agreement dated July 8, 2013, between Contra Costa County and IFPTE, Local 21. A copy of that Settlement Agreement and the List of Represented Classifications is attached.
