**WHEREAS**, Twenty years ago a local high school student introduced Youth-to-Youth to the San Ramon Valley; the idea of a conference was successfully pitched to a local nonprofit, Community Against Substance Abuse (CASA); and

**WHEREAS**, Youth-to-Youth originally started as a conference for high school students, but after the first few conferences, the high school students said the conference should also focus on middle school students when many of them began making decisions about alcohol, drugs and other risky behavior; and

**WHEREAS**, The Youth-to-Youth conference, staffed entirely by high school students, has grown to over 400 local middle school students in attendance; and

**WHEREAS**, High school students work enthusiastically planning drug prevention programs and participating in leadership activities while planning this conference for 6th, 7th and 8th graders; and




