

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-15

(ABOLISHING THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows, abolishing the Human Relations Commission:

**SECTION I. SUMMARY.** This Ordinance repeals Chapter 26-8 of the County Ordinance Code, which established the Human Relations Commission. On November 3, 2009, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2009/513 to abolish several of its advisory boards, committees and commissions, including the Human Relations Commission.

**SECTION II.** Chapter 26-8 of the County Ordinance Code is hereby repealed.

**SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days after passage shall be published once, with the names of the Supervisors voting for or against it, in the Contra Costa Times, a newspaper published in this County.
