In The Matter of: Recognition of SEIU Local 2015 as the successor employee organization to SEIU United Healthcare Workers West, Local 2005.

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors, acting solely in its capacity as the governing board of the Contra Costa County In-Home Supportive Services Public Authority **RESOLVES THAT:**

WHEREAS SEIU United Healthcare Workers West (UHW), Local 2005 is a local affiliate of the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) and is the recognized employee organization for the In-Home Supportive Services Provider Unit;

WHEREAS SEIU reorganized the jurisdiction of its local affiliates in California to consolidate representation of most of its long term care workers in California into one affiliate, namely SEIU Local 2015; and

WHEREAS effective September 1, 2015, the in-home supportive services providers in Contra Costa County who were represented by SEIU UHW, Local 2005 became represented by SEIU Local 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors recognizes SEIU Local 2015 as the successor employee organization to SEIU UHW, Local 2005, and as such, is the recognized employee organization for the In-Home Supportive Services Provider Unit.
