RESOLUTION NO. 2016/532

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors recognizes September, 2016 as Suicide Prevention Awareness Month, shedding light on those suffering with a mental illness, or other behavioral health issues; and

WHEREAS, suicide is a human tragedy that transcends socioeconomic status, age, gender and ethnicity; and

WHEREAS, suicide is the tenth leading cause of all deaths in the United States and the third leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 15 and 24 and takes the lives of nearly 30,000 Americans every year; and

WHEREAS, suicide has an evertasting impact on the survivors who are left to process the loss of their loved ones and who are at an increased risk of suicide themselves; and

WHEREAS, suicide prevention efforts should be developed and encouraged to the maximum extent possible; and

WHER LAS, suicide is preventable through increased knowledge about warning signs, timely intervention, and by limited access to lethal means for those at risk, and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County calls to action the Health Services Department, Public Officials, Private Health Providers and Hospitals, Community Based Organizations, Falth Based Organizations, and Individuals

within our communities to educate and take action to address this devastating public health issue; and

WHEREAS, in September, 2018, the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors adopted a Suicide Prevention

Strategic Plan providing a road map for communities to reduce suicid. Through education increasing awareness of knowing the warning signs, and implementing trainings to equip people with tools needed to help others who consider suicide.
