Pursuant to Sections 22507 of the California Vehicle Code, parking is hereby declared to be prohibited at all times for vehicles 6 feet or more in height (including any load thereon), or 20 feet or more in length on the east and west side of Pacheco Boulevard (Road No. 3951C), beginning from the north curbline prolongation of Arthur Road (Road No. 3681), and extending southerly for a distance of 3432 feet or to the city limit, Martinez area.
