NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that permission is granted to Eleanor Thompson/Social Progress Inc. to partially close Fred Jackson Way, Market Avenue, 5th Street, except for emergency traffic, on July 4, 2018 for the period of 9:00 AM through 12:00 PM, subject to the following conditions:

1. Traffic will be detoured via per traffic control plan reviewed by Public Works.
2. All signing to be in accordance with the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
3. Eleanor Thompson/Social Progress Inc. shall comply with the requirements of the Ordinance Code of Contra Costa County.
4. Provide the County with a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for Comprehensive General Public Liability which names the County as an additional insured prior to permit issuance.
5. Obtain approval for the closure from the Sheriff's Department, the California Highway Patrol and the Fire District.
