IN THE MATTER OF Accepting and Giving Notice of Completion of Contract for the Byron Highway and Camino Diablo Intersection Improvements Project, Byron area. County Project No. 0662-6R4094, Federal Project No. HRRRL 5928(117) (District III)

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors RESOLVES that on May 23, 2017, the County contracted with Granite Rock Company for the work generally consisting of roadway widening, intersection improvements, including sidewalk, curb ramps, and drainage improvements, traffic signal installation, and traffic signal and roadway improvements within Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, at the intersection of Byron Highway and Camino Diablo in the Byron area, with Western Insurance Company as surety, for work performed on the grounds of the County; and

The Public Works Director reports that said work has been inspected and complies with the approved plans, special provisions and standard specifications and recommends its acceptance as complete as of April 5, 2018.
