

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-19

REPEAL OF ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL TAX FOR POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES
IN COUNTY SERVICE AREA P-2, ZONE A

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Findings and Purpose.

- A. On May 21, 2019, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 2019-13, which authorized a special tax for police protection services in County Service Area P-2, Zone A.
- B. Also on May 21, 2019, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2019/147, which directed Ordinance No. 2019-13 to be presented to the voters of County Service Area P-2, Zone A, in a mail-ballot election on August 27, 2019.
- C. On May 30, 2019, at a special meeting, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2019/191, which ordered the withdrawal of Ordinance No. 2019-13 from the August 27, 2019, ballot, pursuant to Elections Code section 9605.
- D. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Ordinance No. 2019-13.

SECTION II. Repeal. Ordinance No. 2019-13 is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective immediately after passage, pursuant to Elections Code section 9141. Within 15 days after passage, this ordinance shall be published once with the names of supervisors voting for or against it in the East Bay Times, a newspaper published in this County.
