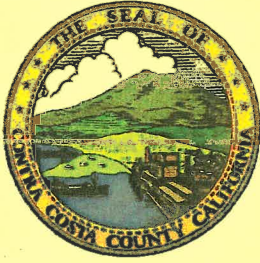

yet have a solution.

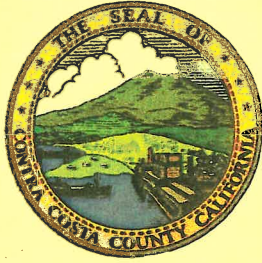
I've heard the Historical Society does not have
