Resolution No. 2020/30

WHEREAS, in October 2019, PG&E instituted a series of Public Safety Power Outages for Contra Costa County; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa Health Services notified health facilities, including nursing homes and local hospitals about the power shutoff and monitored them for impact; and

WHEREAS, medically vulnerable residents relying on durable medical equipment that may be affected by the power outage were identified and monitored for safety; and

WHEREAS, John Muir Health, representing John Muir Concord Medical Center and John Muir Walnut Creek Medical Center, served as charging stations available 24 hours per day; and

WHEREAS, John Muir Health provided critical service to those most in need during a precarious situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County does hereby acknowledge John Muir Health's prompt response to the needs of the community.


