In the matter of recognizing Contra Costa Regional Medical Center's prompt response to the needs of the community during the PSPS

Resolution No. 2020/33

WHEREAS, in October 2019, PG&E instituted a series of Public Safety Power Outages for Contra Costa County; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa Health Services notified health facilities, including nursing homes and local hospitals about the power shutoff and monitored them for impact; and

WHEREAS, medically vulnerable residents relying on durable medical equipment that may be affected by the power outage were identified and monitored for safety; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa Regional Medical Center served as charging stations available 24 hours per day; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa Regional Medical Center provided critical service to those most in need during a precarious situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County does hereby acknowledge Contra Costa Regional Medical Center's prompt response to the needs of the community.


