In The Matter Of: Establishing a Expense Stipend for the Juvenile Justice Commssion

WHEREAS the Juvenile Justice Commission was created pursuant to Welfare & Institutions Code § 225; and

WHEREAS the Juvenile Justices Commission's primary responsibility is to provide citizen oversight of the juvenile justice system, which includes inspecting juvenile hall, police departments holding youth, and group homes in the county; and

WHEREAS Welfare & Institutions Code § 231 provides that in lieu of reimbursement to Juvenile Justice Commission members for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, the Board of Supervisors may provide that the members of the Juvenile Justice Commission shall be paid not to exceed the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25) per meeting not exceeding two meetings per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supevisors approves and authorizes the payment of twenty-five dollars (\$25) per meeting not exceeding two meetings per month to the members of the Juvenile Justice Commission in lieu of reimbursement to the members of the Juvenile Justice Commission for the actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
