### **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-26**

# (Delete classifications of Chief Deputy Treasurer-Tax Collector-Exempt & Labor Relations Manager-Exempt & Non-substantive Section Reorganization & Heading Update)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows (omitting the parenthetical footnotes from the official text of the enacted or amended provisions of the County Ordinance Code):

**SECTION I**: Section 33-5.397 of the County Ordinance Code is retitled and amended to delete the classification of Chief Deputy Treasurer-Tax Collector-Exempt, and is amended to read as follows:

#### 33-5.397 - Treasurer-tax collector.

- (a) The assistant county treasurer is excluded and is appointed by the treasurer-tax collector.
- (b) The assistant county tax collector is excluded and is appointed by the treasurer-tax collector.
- (c)The treasurer's investment officer is excluded and is appointed by the treasurer-tax collector.

**SECTION II**: Section 33-5.413 of the County Ordinance Code is amended to delete the classification of Labor Relations Manager-Exempt and to move the Chief of Labor Relations-Exempt classification to Section 33-5.307, and is amended to read as follows:

#### 33-5.413 - Human resources.

- (a) The director of human resources-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the county administrator.
- (b) The assistant director of human resources-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the director of human resources-exempt.
- (c)The human resources manager-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the director of human resources-exempt.

**SECTION III:** Section 33-5.307 of the County Ordinance Code is amended to move the

Chief of Labor Relations-Exempt classification to Section 33-5.307 from Section 33-5.413, and is amended to read as follows:

## 33-5.307 - County administrator.

- (a) The county administrator is excluded and is appointed by the board of supervisors.
- (b) The following positions in the county administrator's office are excluded and are appointed by the county administrator: chief assistant county administrator; assistant county administrator; manager capital facilities and debt management-exempt; executive assistant I to the county administrator-exempt; executive assistant II to the county administrator-exempt; chief public communications officer-exempt, director of the office of children services-exempt, county finance director-exempt, and chief of labor relations-exempt.
