IN THE MATTER OF: Approving and Authorizing the Public Works Director, or designee, to fully close a portion of Sunset Drive between Franciscan Way and Arlington Avenue, Highgate Road between Sunset Drive and Edwing Drive, and Highgate Court, on November 9, 2021 through April 30, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m., for the purpose of the installation of approximately 5,165' of 6" & 8" Earthquake Resistant Ductile Iron (ERDIP) water main, Kensington area. (District I)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that permission is granted to East Bay Municipal Utility District to fully close a portion of Sunset Drive between Franciscan Way and Arlington Avenue, Highgate Road between Sunset Drive and Edwing Drive, and Highgate Court, except for emergency traffic, local residents, trash collection, and U.S. Postal Services, on November 9, 2021 through April 30, 2022 from 7:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m., subject to the following conditions:

1. Traffic will be detoured via neighboring streets per traffic control plan reviewed by Public Works.
2. All signing to be in accordance with the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
3. East Bay Municipal Utility District shall comply with the requirements of the Ordinance Code of Contra Costa County.
4. Provide the County with a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for Comprehensive General Public Liability which names the County as an additional insured prior to permit issuance.
5. Obtain approval for the closure from the Kensington Police Protection and Community Service District and the Kensington Fire Protection District.
