In The Matter Of: Providing for Salary Increases for Specified Unrepresented Sworn Employees in the District Attorney Department

WHEREAS the County of Contra Costa has maintained historic salary ties between sworn unrepresented and represented classifications; and

WHEREAS the District Attorney Investigators' Association has recently negotiated a new Memorandum of Understanding including wage increases;

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors acting solely in its capacity as the Governing Board of the County of Contra Costa **RESOLVES THAT:**

The base rate of pay for the classifications of DA Adjutant of Senior Inspectors - Exempt (6KD2), DA Chief of Inspectors-Exempt (6KD1), DA Director of Forensic & Technical Services (6KDC), and the DA Lieutenant of Inspectors (6KNB), will be increased as follows:

- Effective July 1, 2023, five percent (5.0%)
- Effective July 1, 2024, five percent (5.0%)
- Effective July 1, 2025, five percent (5.0%)
