RECOMMENDATION(S):

BACKGROUND:

ConMed Corporation offers a line of endomechanical instrumentation for minimally invasive laparoscopic procedures, including but not limited to trocars, dissectors, graspers, ligation and stapling devices and suction/irrigation products. ConMed Corporation also provides electrosurgical generators, hand pieces, smoke management systems and accessories. These products enable the Health Services Department to provide a large variety of procedures to patients to improve the state of their health.
