Subject: Interagency Agreement #28-697-12 with Antioch Unified School District

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Interagency Agreement #28-697-12 with Antioch Unified School District, a government agency, to pay County an amount not to exceed \$5,600, for the Public Health Clinic Services Scoliosis Screening Project for its 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, for the period from September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Approval of this Interagency Agreement will allow Antioch School District to pay County \$4.00 per student to support the Public Health Clinic Services Scoliosis Screening Project. No County match required.

**BACKGROUND:**

Antioch School District has requested that Contra Costa Health Services, Public Health Clinic Services, provide Scoliosis Screening Clinics at their middle schools for their 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls and 8<sup>th</sup>
