RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #74-343-4 with Richard D. Baldwin, M.D., a self-employed individual, in an amount not to exceed \$220,800, to provide professional geriatric psychiatric services for County's Adult Mental Health Clinics, for the period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

For a number of years the County has contracted with Medical, Dental and Mental Health Specialists to provide specialized professional services, which are not otherwise available in its Hospital and Health Centers.

On January 10, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-343-3 with Richard D. Baldwin, M.D. for the provision of geriatric psychiatric services for seriously and
