RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute a novation contract with Rainbow Community Center of Contra Costa County, in an amount not to exceed \$138,506, to provide Mental Health Services Act prevention and early intervention services for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, with a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$69,253. (100% Mental Health Services Act)

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

of Supervisors approved Contract #74-375-2 with Rainbow Community Center of Contra Costa County, for the period from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2012, for the provision of MHSA prevention and early intervention services.

Approval of Novation Contract #74-375-3 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract, and allows Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2013.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, Contractor will not provide outreach and community engagement events, support groups, in-services, and counseling to the LGBTQ community and their families.

CHILDREN'S IMPACT STATEMENT:
