RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-164-20 with Agostini & Associates, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$500,000, to provide temporary nursing, therapy, pharmacy and other medical professional staff for Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers and the County's Detention Facility, for the period from November 1, 2012 through October 31, 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Enterprise Fund I. No increase in rates.

BACKGROUND:

On October 25, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-164-19 with Agostini & Associates, Inc. for the period from November 1, 2010 through October 31, 2011, to provide temporary staff to assist Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers and the County's Detention Facility during peak loads, temporary absences, and emergency situations.
