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## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a Consulting Services Agreement with Quincy Engineering, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, for on-call civil engineering services for the period of December 1, 2012 through December 1, 2015, Countywide.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Work performed under this on-call consulting services agreement is funded by developer fees; and various other local, state and federal funds for road, flood control, and airport projects.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Public Works Department is involved in various projects in the County which require civil engineering services for road, flood control, and airport projects. After a solicitation process, this firm was selected as one of the three firms to provide civil engineering services on an "on-call" basis. The consultant will augment Public Works Design/Construction staff on an as-needed basis. They will be used as an extension of Public Works staff during busy times when extra help is needed or when in-house expertise is not available. This on-call
