Subject: Purchase Order - Rotocraft Support, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent to execute, on behalf of the Sheriff-Coroner, a purchase order with Rotocraft Support, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$135,200 for the purchase and installation of radios in both Sheriff's Office helicopters. (100% Law Enforcement Capital Projects Fund)

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$135,200. 100% Law Enforcement Capital Projects-Communications (Fund 105600).

BACKGROUND:

With the CCC Office of the Sheriff switching over to the new 800 MHz radio system, it has become necessary to purchase new radios and have them professionally installed in our helicopters by an FAA certified Avionics Specialist. Rotocraft Support, Inc. is currently providing aircraft maintenance services for the Sheriff's Office two helicopters. The Sheriff's Office is purchasing two radios to comply with the 800 MHz system. The radios are a special brand product that Rotocraft Support, Inc. specializes in and they are a recommended provider of the Technisonic Radios compatible with our current radio system. The helicopters both need to be taken to Rotocraft Support, Inc. for updating logs,
