The Materials Division purchases fuel for the station by accepting daily bids from fuel distributors. They currently have five (5) vendors submitting bids and are set up to purchase from all of them. All five of the vendors are in need of new purchase orders. Southern Counties Fuel is the County's primary vendor, followed by Ramos Oil Company, Inc., Royal Petroleum, Redwood Coast Petroleum and Hunt & Sons,
