RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #24-403-12 with Jon Whalen, M.D, a self-employed individual, in an amount not to exceed \$300,800, to provide professional outpatient psychiatric services at the East County Medical Clinic for the period from February 1, 2014 through January 31, 2015.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Realignment, offset by third-party billing. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

For a number of years the County has contracted with Medical, Dental and Mental Health Specialists to provide specialized professional services, which are not otherwise available.
